

RESOLUTION NO. 2022- 11

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CUERO, TEXAS, CANVASSING THE ELECTION RETURNS FOR COUNCILMEMBER DISTRICT 2, COUNCILMEMBER DISTRICT 3 AND MAYOR AND DECLARING THE RESULTS OF AN ELECTION.

WHEREAS, an election was held in the City of Cuero, Texas, on May 7, 2022, for the purpose of electing, according to law, a Councilmember District 2, a Councilmember District 3 and Mayor; and

WHEREAS, having considered the results of said election and having duly canvassed same as required by law, the City Council of the City of Cuero here now finds and determines that said election was duly and legally called and held and that the Returns of such election were duly made by the Judges of said election as required by law and that there were cast at such election the following votes for the hereinafter named candidates, to-wit:
