AN RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CUERO, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING AND APPROVING THE DONATION OF PERSONAL PROPERTY BEING A 2006 WELLS FARGO UTILITY WAGON(TRAILER), VIN #1WC20012962055014, BY THE CITY OF CUERO TO THE CUERO REGIONAL HOSPITAL TO BE USED AS A MOBILE EMERGENCY MEDICAL CLINIC IN THE CITY OF CUERO AND IN DEWITT COUNTY, TEXAS, BEING FOUND TO BE A PUBLIC PURPOSE THE BENEFITS THE CITY OF CUERO.

WHEREAS, the City of Cuero, a Texas Municipal Corporation, owns a 2006 Wells Fargo Utility Wagon Trailer, VIN #1WC20012962055014(“Wagon”); and

WHEREAS, the City of Cuero desires to donate the said Wagon to the Cuero Regional Hospital to be used for a mobile emergency clinic within the City Cuero and DeWitt County and surrounding counties; and

WHEREAS, such donation of said Wagon, being personal property of the City of Cuero, shall be for a public purpose that will benefit the City of Cuero; and

WHEREAS, the Cuero Regional Hospital has approved the receipt of the donation of the Wagon and will comply with the condition of use as a mobile emergency clinic; and

WHEREAS, the agreement between the City of Cuero and the Cuero Regional Hospital is attached hereto as Exhibit “A”; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Cuero does herenow approve the donation of the Wagon to the Cuero Regional Hospital as provided in the interlocal agreement attached hereto in Exhibit “A”;

WHEREAS, the Mayor is hereby authorized to sign and execute said agreement attached hereto as Exhibit “A” and any additional documentation to effectuate the donation of the Wagon to the Cuero Regional Hospital; and

NOWHEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CUERO, TEXAS:

SECTION ONE. That the City Council of the City of Cuero does hereby approve the donation of the 2006 Wells Fargo Utility Wagon Trailer, VIN #1WC20012962055014 to the Cuero Regional Hospital for use as a mobile emergency clinic in the City of Cuero, DeWitt County and any surrounding counties under the terms and conditions in the interlocal agreement attached hereto as Exhibit “A”.

SECTION TWO. That the Mayor is hereby authorized to sign and execute said agreement attached hereto as Exhibit “A” and any additional documentation to effectuate the donation of the Wagon to the Cuero Regional Hospital.

Exhibit A

INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT

THIS INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT made and entered into pursuant to the Texas Intergovernmental Cooperation Act, Govt. Code, Title 7, Chapter 791 by and between the City of Cuero (“CITY”) and Cuero Regional Hospital (“HOSPITAL”).

WHEREAS, the CITY a Texas Municipal Corporation, owns a 2006 Wells Fargo Utility Wagon Trailer, VIN #1WC20012962055014(“Wagon”); and

WHEREAS, the CITY desires to donate the said Wagon to the HOSPITAL to be used for a mobile emergency clinic within the City Cuero, DeWitt County and surrounding counties; and

WHEREAS, such donation of said Wagon, being personal property of the CITY, shall be for a public purpose that will benefit the CITY; and

WHEREAS, the HOSPITAL has approved the receipt of the donation of the Wagon and will comply with the condition of use as a mobile emergency clinic; and

NOW THEREFORE, for the mutual covenants and considerations as expressed herein, the CITY and HOSPITAL agree as follows:

1. CITY and HOSPITAL warrant that both possesses adequate legal authority to enter into this interlocal agreement. The CITY and HOSPITAL’S local governing bodies have authorized its signatory official to enter into this agreement and to bind the governing bodies to the terms of this agreement and any subsequent amendments hereto.
2. CITY and HOSPITAL agree to conduct all activities under this agreement in accordance with all applicable rules, regulations, ordinances and law.
3. The CITY does hereby donate the 2006 Wells Fargo Utility Wagon Trailer, VIN #1WC20012962055014, including all of the CITY’S right, title and interest in said Wagon to the HOSPITAL.
4. The Hospital shall use the said Wagon exclusively as a mobile emergency clinic within the City, DeWitt County, and surrounding counties.
5. This Interlocal agreement and any attachments, as provided herein, constitute the complete agreement between the parties hereto, and supersede any and all oral and written agreements between the parties relating to matter herein. Except as otherwise provided herein, this contract cannot be modified without the written consent of the parties.
