

REPORT FOR CITY COUNCIL MEETING
SCORING OF RFQ'S FOR ENGINEERING SERVICES
FOR THE GLO CDBG-MIT/MOD APPLICATION PROCESS AND IMPLEMENTATION

The City of Cuero advertised a Request for Qualifications for Engineer services as a part of the plan to apply for the upcoming Community Development Block Grant Program MIT/MOD Program through the Golden Crescent Regional Planning Commission. The request for qualifications seeks to find an engineer and/or engineering firm to prepare all preliminary and final design plans and specifications and to conduct all necessary interim and final inspections as well as assisting in preparation and project implementation of the CDBG-MIT/MOD contract, if awarded, to support eligible infrastructure improvements in the City.

The City Manager received two proposals in response to this Request for Qualifications. A Committee that included Raymond Zella, Caroline Hawes, Jennifer Zufelt and Rhonda Stastny individually scored each proposal based on the published criteria. Following is the result of scoring.

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| CivilCorp Engineers | 388 points |
| Urban Engineering & Surveying | 397 points |

The Scoring Committee is recommending that the City Council accept the scoring as presented and authorize the City Manager to negotiate and award a contract with the Urban Engineering, as the highest ranking firm. The City Manager will present the proposed engineering contract to City Council at a future meeting for final approval.
