5/25/2021 - Minutes

1. Call To Order And Announce A Quorum Is Present

Mayor Meyer called the meeting to order at 12:00 pm.

Members present: Mayor Sara Post Meyer, Mayor Pro Tem Bill Matthys, Councilmembers John Fuqua, Terry Glover and Mitch Adams.

2. Public Comments

Megan Boehl and Ann Marie Mees from the Boys and Girls Club of DeWitt County spoke to Council about the successful golf tournament and how much the Parks Department assisted during the rain.

Utility Supervisor Wayne Berger and Assistant to the Utility Supervisor Rhonda Stastny, informed Council that the City will be getting \$4.28 million dollar grant that was approved to the new water well, and new water lines.
