

## GENERAL FLORAL REGULATIONS

The following floral regulations are made in the best interest of all concerned in order that Hillside Cemetery may always be a place of abiding beauty and a source of continual satisfaction to families and friends of those entrusted in our care.

### SELECTED RULES & REGULATIONS

- Placement of fresh and artificial flowers in permanent bronze/granite/marble/stone vases are allowed year round.
- All decorations will be removed March 15 of each year for general cleanup.
- Potted plants, wreaths, baskets, easels and flags will be allowed 7 days preceding and 20 days following the holiday periods of Labor Day, Valentine Day, Easter, Decoration Day, Mother's Day, Memorial Day, Father's Day and Veterans Day. Please pick up decorations you wish to save before those dates.
- All flowers will be removed when their appearance becomes withered, faded or unsightly or when they interfere with ground maintenance.
- Floral stands, wreaths, baskets and other floral tributes, which are a part of a floral offering at the time of interment, will remain until wilted and then will be removed.
- Holiday season arrangements, wreaths, flowers or decorations are permitted from November 20<sup>th</sup> through January 30<sup>th</sup>. All holiday arrangements not removed by January 30<sup>th</sup> will be discarded.
- Statues, vigil lights, glass or breakable containers or objects are not permitted.
- Dogs entering cemetery grounds must be kept on a leash at all times, and all droppings must be cleaned up.
- Existing trees, shrubs and all other plantings that through growth encroach on lot owners property, become unsightly, diseased or damaged by accident or weather, will be removed at management's discretion.

A WORD OF CAUTION... three problems beyond our control are strong winds, deer and feral hogs, and theft of flowers from the vases. Sometimes flowers are missing due to these reasons.
